

## POWER LINEMAN (TRAINEE)

Definition of Class

This is beginning level work including extensive on-the-job training leading to qualification as a lineman.

Work of this class involves on-the-job training and experience in the work of a Power Lineman. The employee starts out performing limited lineman duties and is slowly given experience in work on power lines. Work experience extends to helping to set poles, string wires, install transformers, etc. After 4 years experience, employees in this class should be eligible for promotion to the class Power Lineman. If after 5 years experience they do not qualify, they should be terminated from the program.

Examples of Work Performed

Employees in this class learn to perform all of the duties outlined for the class Power Lineman.

Knowledges, Skills and Abilities

Sufficient learning ability to acquire the knowledge of a Power Lineman.  
Ability to work at heights.  
Good physical health and strength.  
Common sense and the ability to adhere to procedures.

Minimum Requirements of Training and Experience

Graduation from a standard or vocational high school.
